It will be some time before all is entered, but I believe it will be worth it in the long run. The system is called DOSSIER by Arsenault Associates, based in New Jersey. Each of the systems that I looked at had good features and bad but for my analytical mind and my expectations of what will happen when I push a particular button, this system was my choice.
