

Source for Decals and Interior Signs

**The Question:** Do you currently post a sign over the inside of the rear door on your fixed route buses saying something like "No standing allowed in the step wells?" If so, can you please tell us where you purchased the decal from? If you are not currently posting this sign and are interested in doing so, please let me know. Perhaps a joint order can help reduce the price. If you have a distributor you use for other types of interior decals/signs, this information would be helpful as well.

**Ben Franklin Transit** says... No, we do not have such a decal.

**Clallam Transit** says... We do not use signs of this nature.

**Columbia County Public Transportation** says...We do not have any fixed route buses and do not allow standing in any of our vehicles.

**Community Transit** says... Since the vast majority of our coaches are Low Floor, we do not have Step Wells. On the few that we do have, there are no signs for this issue.

**CUBS** says... No, we do not have a sign for the rear step wells. As far as I know, it has not been a problem for our system.

**Jefferson Transit** says... We do not currently post that information; however, I believe it is an excellent idea! Any decals that we cannot make ourselves we simply purchase locally. If, however, a consortium were developed...count us in. We would purchase approximately 25.

**Kitsap Transit** says... We produce all our interior bus signage ourselves.

**Mason Transit** says... All of our buses at MTA have what we refer to as a "Standee Line" at the most forward of the passenger compartment. It is actually a yellow line that is specified in the procurement process and is made directly into the floor of the vehicle. In addition to the standee Line, there is a posted sign in plain view of the passengers that states, "No Standees Forward of Yellow Line". This meets requirements allowing passengers to stand in the compartment and use overhead stanchions and handrails.

**Skagit Transit** says... We do not have any signs to discourage passengers from sitting or standing in the rear step well. We are very interested in posting this sign.

**Spokane Transit** says... We usually go out for bid on these – the vendors that usually do our decals is Eclipse Screen Printing – Matt Sarnier – (509) 922-7700 and Screen Tek, Inc. – Nancy – (509) 928-8322...for the interior signage is Screen Tek, Inc. (they're usually the successful vendor) and the other vendor is Washington Screen Print & Graphics – Chris – 800-511-1859...

**Valley Transit** says... We do have these types of signs on our buses. They are specified when we order the vehicles from the manufactures. We have not had to install our own signs.
